

Buying your raffle tickets:

1. Choose how many tickets you want to buy. Tickets are **£1 each**
2. Send payment via Paypal to <https://www.paypal.com/paypalme/LittlePaxtonSA>.
3. Fill in the online form (shown below) at [LPSA Christmas Hamper Raffle \(office.com\)](https://www.lpsa.org.uk/ChristmasHamperRaffle/office.com)
4. Based on the information given in your form, once we have matched your details with appropriate payment, we will assign you raffle ticket numbers.
5. **The absolute cutoff date for buying tickets is 8 pm Tuesday 15th December. We cannot guarantee that any tickets bought after this time will be included in the draw.**
6. The winning tickets (each winning one of 14 Christmas hampers) will be selected in the draw on Wednesday 16th December using a random number generator.
